**International Student Orientation**

Welcome to Delta School District! Please see the following registration and orientation information.

Step 1: Come to **Delta School Board Office when you arrive in Canada** (the International Program office is open all summer for your convenience, Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.). Our address is 4585 Harvest Drive, Delta. We will start your medical coverage and confirm your registration into Delta School District. **Please bring your passport, study permit and Custodian Declaration (Parent) papers.**

Step 2: Please attend an orientation and welcome at **Delview Secondary, 9111 - 116 Street, Delta, from 9:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 30, 2017.** Go to the main office and ask for the International Coordinator, Ms. Diane Stevens. Students will review their courses and have a school tour in addition to English testing and orientation information. A welcome snack will be provided and a chance to meet leadership students. Please bring a 3-ring binder with a package of lined paper, pens, and a dictionary or translator.

Step 3: You are invited to a FREE new student sightseeing and welcome celebration on **Friday, September 1, 2017.** Meet at **Sands Secondary School** (10840 – 82 Avenue, Delta) at **9:00am.** Pick up is at **4:30 pm.** New students will go to Granville Island and walk along the harbor, see the market, houseboats, shops, artist studios, and listen to the street performers. Next, students will go to the welcome party at the bowling centre. We have approximately 200 new international students coming to Delta this year. This is a great opportunity to meet new friends and get to know other students from your school. **Please bring your lunch and a water bottle or beverage and good walking shoes.**

Step 4: Please come to **Delview Secondary School at 10:00 a.m.** on the first day of school - **Tuesday, September 5, 2017.** Go to the main entrance and Ms. Diane Stevens, International Coordinator, will meet you by the seating area inside the front door foyer. **Dismissal time will be 11:00 a.m.** Please bring a 3-ring binder, a package of lined paper, a pencil or pen and homestay address/contact information.
